right. From Hwy 12 to Orillia, at Hwy 11 overpass go over Hwy 11, turn left  
immediately on Cty. Rd. 11 (Old Barrie Rd) Go to Oro Line 12, turn right to first stop  
sign. Turn left to Oro line 10, turn right, farm 2nd on left.
